WARROOK FARM – SCHOOL EXCURSIONS

Warrook farm is a working farm located only 1 hour from Melbourne on the South Gippsland Highway, Monomeith. (on the way to Phillip Island)

Warrook farm is able to provide children with a hand on farm experience and is a wonderful place to learn about farm activities and animals.

A STUDENT VISIT TO WARROOK FARM WILL INCLUDE

- Animal feeding in the baby animal nursery
- A cow milking demonstration
- A wagon ride to our Historic Shearing Shed
- A sheep shearing demonstration. Our experienced shearer will explain the process of shearing a sheep and other wool shed tasks such as wool classing and the transition of wool from the shed to the shop.
- A working Dog demonstration – see how they round up the sheep
- Visit to our Fauna Park to see kangaroos, wombats, emu and other native bird life.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Duration – usually about 1.5 hours
- Suggested arrival time 10-10.15am. The children can have their morning tea on arrival and start the tour about 10.30 am. The children are welcome to stay and eat their lunch at Warrook after the tour.
- We have a partly enclosed / undercover area as well as a number of outdoor tables if the weather is fine.
